Alma was the last Club 44 member to pass away and she would always speak of how hard it was to describe the incredible bond that all the woman had with each other. In addition to being a Club 44 member, Alma volunteered at St. John Vianney Church and she was active at the Mentor Senior Center when she moved to Mentor. She enjoyed wood carving and playing pool.
