



## Carl G. Vinson

February 10, 1930 - March 23, 2020

Carl G. Vinson Jr., age 90 of Eastlake, OH, passed away Monday, March 23, 2020, at the Louis Stokes Cleveland VA Medical Center, Cleveland, OH. The Cleveland VA has helped Carl get the most out of life over nearly the past two decades.

Carl was born on February 10, 1930, in Yonkers, NY. Carl grew up in St. Louis surrounded by extended family where he developed his strong Christian faith which stayed with him throughout his life, being an active member of Good Shepherd and Faith Lutheran Churches in Mentor.

Mr. Vinson retired from Ricerca (Diamond Shamrock) in Concord Township after 30 years. He was a proud graduate of Washington University in St. Louis, where he began his education in chemistry. After a stint serving in the Army stateside during the Korean War, he returned to school to study chemical engineering at the University of Illinois and the University of Michigan where he received his PhD in Chemical Engineering and met his wife, Barbara.

Carl had many interests over the years, though his abiding interest was in chemistry and engineering. Science and math books were his favorite study materials, though he enjoyed reading on the great people of history as well. In his earlier days, Carl enjoyed trains and the industry that grew around the rails – taking regular trips to Chicago to walk the rails. He was also an avid cyclist in the days before helmets and cycling-specific gear were common. He would regularly take long rides from his office into the Lake and Geauga County countryside.

Survivors include his wife of 55 years, Barbara Alm Vinson; sons Jonathan “Jack” (Marci Cohen) Vinson and Robert “Bob” (Monika) Vinson; and grandchildren Graham, Hogarth, Nora, and Amelia Vinson.

Preceding Carl in death are his parents, Edna and Carl G. Vinson; and stepmother, Esther Vinson.
