David "Dave" Kelley age 81 of Mentor, passed away Thursday, March 17, 2022 at home with his family by his side. He was born October 25, 1940 in Pittsburgh, PA.

Dave was a successful business owner and operator of Watson Power Bulk Material Handling. He was also co-founder of J's Pizza Market, Mentor.

Dave served as Captain in the United States Air Force. During his time in the military, he was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Air Force Longevity Service Award as well as the Small Arms Expert Marksmanship Ribbon. He graduated from Shaler High School in Glenshaw, PA, where he met his high school sweetheart and future wife, Eileen. Dave earned his business degree from Penn State University, and was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity. Dave was a black belt in Minna Jiu Jitsu and Karate.

Dave was smart, kind, a great listener and had the best sense of humor. The laughter was always loudest when Dave was in the room. He was the best kind of friend, father and grandfather, always there if you needed him, giving great advice whether it was about business opportunities, building or remodeling a house, life in general and so much more.
