Iris Dawn Parker, age 56, of Painesville, died January 23, 2021 at University Hospital in Cleveland. She was born September 11, 1964 in Washington, North Carolina.

Iris worked as an international photographer, artist, and educator who spent ten years living and working in Johannesburg, South Africa.

Her hobbies included photo journalism, documentary photography and youth mentorship. She enjoyed conducting photography and life skills workshops in communities all over South Africa and the United States. Along with being a curator of photography, Iris also worked in the Cultural Studies Program at Columbia College in Chicago, Illinois. Iris was a Fulbright Memorial Fellow Scholar (Japan).

Survivors include her siblings, Lee (Sandra) Coffee, Sam (Ann) Parker Jr., Darnell (Bud) Woods, Omar Parker, Donna (Sly) Link, Mary V. Parker, Frank Parker, Alveno (Tammy) Parker, Nicole Manning, and a host of nieces and nephews.
