Joyce G. Dirrman, 84, resident of Breckenridge Village in Willoughby formerly of Mentor, passed away on Friday, June 4, 2021 at Lake West Medical Center, Willoughby.

Joyce graduated from Andrews School with a major in Business Administration in 1955 and began her career as a Secretary for the Case Western Math Department in 1956; shortly thereafter, she became an Executive Secretary to the Claims Director of Progressive Insurance Co. until 1962. She married Richard Carl Dirrman in 1956 and celebrated 54 years of marriage before his passing in 2010. Her service to the City of Willowick began in 1978 as a Secretary to City Council and in 1980, accepted full-time employment as an Executive Administrative Secretary for nearly 28 years serving seven Finance Directors in addition as Liason to four City Law Directors. She received the G. Fred Martin Award for Public Service in 1995 and retired in 2006.
