Thomas E. "Tom" Swider age 66, of Brunswick, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, August 15, 2021 at Metro-Health Medical Center, Cleveland. He was born September 2, 1954 in Wheeling, WV.

Tom was a Willowick Firefighter from 1979 until retirement in 2005. He also worked as a Communications Specialist, dispatching, and coordinating for Metro Life Flight from 1986 until retirement in 2010.
