Aase (Borup) Schoyen, 85, of Painesville, beloved daughter, wife, mother, grandmother and friend, passed away Friday Feb. 7, 2014 at home surrounded by her daughters after a most valiant, but short battle with cancer on the day that would have been her 61st anniversary.
