Anthony R. Mazzocco, age 87 of Mentor, passed Monday, January 15, 2024 at home surrounded by his family.

He was born October 15, 1936 in Leechburg, PA. After high school he enlisted in the Army and served in Germany for two years. After serving in the Army, Tony came back home, earned an engineering degree from Fenn College of Engineering and from there went on to earn a Juris Doctor from Cleveland-Marshall Law School.

Tony practiced law for over thirty years, retired his law practice and then began substitute teaching at the Mentor Local School District. In addition, Tony taught Construction Law at Lakeland Community College for 40 + years. He was also a long standing member and past Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus, Euclid Council 3164.

Tony was happiest at family dinners; cookouts, working outside in the yard attending to his flowers, and his tomato plants all while smoking a cigar. He especially enjoyed lively rounds of Schwick with the extended family on Christmas day.
