On February 11, 2019, a band of angels graciously welcomed Audrey M. Hurray to the heavenly choir. Audrey, age 82 of Mentor, passed away at the David Simpson Hospice House in Cleveland. She was born June 23, 1936 in Canton, OH.

Ms. Hurray had worked as a music teacher for the Perry School District for 31 years, retiring in 2006. She was a longtime, devout member of St. Gabriel Catholic Church; where she sang in the choir and served as a heavenly duster.
