Bennett S. Daniels Jr., 87, a lifelong Willoughby resident, passed away Saturday, Oct. 13, 2012, at Fairmount Health Center.

Born April 19, 1925, in Mentor, Mr. Daniels was an engineer at the Albert M. Higley Company in Cleveland for 20 years and General Electric Nela Park Division in Cleveland for 17 years until his retirement in 1987.

Mr. Daniels attended Willoughby Union High School, Denison University where he obtained his B.S. degree and Fenn College where he obtained his B.S.C.E. degree. He was a United States Marine Corp. veteran who served in World War II and the Korean War. He attained rank of Captain before being honorably discharged. He was a member of the Willoughby Masonic Lodge 302 and the Boy Scouts of America.
