She was competitive and loved playing golf and games, particularly bridge. Mom revealed more of her artistic abilities by taking up painting in her eighties. Regarding the arts, you would always hear classical music floating through the air at home. She was a benefactor and great fan of the Cleveland Playhouse and Orchestra.
