Carl "Drago" Berger, age 72, passed away Friday, February 23, 2018 at Lake West Hospital in Willoughby, Ohio. He was a resident of Kirtland Rehabilitation and Care. He was born August 13, 1945 in Braunau am Inn, Austria to the late Vinko and Dragica Berger.
