



Casimir "Cas" Zygadlo

March 3, 1933 - March 26, 2023

Casimir "Cas" Zygadlo, 90, passed away March 26, 2023 at Carington Park Nursing Home due to complications of dementia.

Born March 3, 1933 in Cleveland, Ohio, the youngest son of Adam and Mary (Towalski) Zygadlo. Cas graduated from Thomas Edison High School in 1950. He then began work as a carpenter's apprentice. On December 12, 1951, he married the love of his life, Bernice "Bie" Uline and celebrated 66 years together.

In 1953, during Korea, Cas was drafted into the U.S. Army, and served as a medic. After completing his duty in 1955, he returned to Cleveland and finished his apprenticeship. He became a union journeymen carpenter for Local #435, of which he was a member for 68 years.

Cas moved from Cleveland to Mentor with his wife Bie in 1962. He built their house and resided there for over 58 years. He was also a member of St. Mary of the Assumption Church in Mentor.

After retiring in 1995, Cas continued to use his knowledge and skills restoring his son's century old farm in Ashtabula. He was a true "Mr. Fix It." There was nothing he couldn't disassemble, repair, and reassemble – no manuals needed. He was interested in everything mechanical and electrical. His

favorite hobby was radio controlled aircraft.

Cas is survived by his only child, son, Anthony. He is preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Walter; a sister, Mary; and his beloved wife, "Bie."
