Charles W. "Chuck" Austin, 85 of Painesville Twp., passed away Wednesday March 23, 2022 at UH Tri-Point Medical Center, Concord. He was born May 16, 1936 in Cleveland to the late J.W. and Florence Austin. He grew up in the Cleveland (eastside) and Collinwood areas.

Chuck spent 37 years as a Letter Carrier at the Mentor Post Office, retiring in 2000. He assisted in the annual National Association of Letter Carriers Annual Food Drive even after retirement. He was a proud member of Branch 4195 of the National Association of Letter Carriers for 58 years. Chuck was a lifelong Mickey Mouse fan, a constant visitor to Walt Disney World, and after retirement worked at local Disney Stores. Chuck enjoyed golfing with anyone and everyone. He enjoyed camping and traveling throughout the United States. Although he was unable to serve in the armed forces, he was very proud of his 3 children, 2 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren, who served in the Marine Corps, Army and Navy.
