Charles A. Copeland, age 83 of Mentor, went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Friday April 27, 2018 surrounded by his loving family. He was born November 17, 1934 in Akron, Ohio.

Charles served in the U.S. Air Force, repairing radar and other instruments to keep pilots safe. He worked and retired as a Postmaster of the U. S. Postal Service for the greater Akron area. Following retirement of the post office, he was able to substitute bus drive for the Springfield, Ohio community school district and earn his small pilot's license.

In his spare time Charles enjoyed golfing, playing the piano, photography, shuffleboard and country scene painting. He was an active member in his Florida community, where he was part of the community's barbershop quartet and served as President of the Ohio club. Charles was also quite the one for travel. His most talked about travels included a cross country RV trip and his time spent in Italy.
