Charles P. "Chuck" McMillan Sr., age 83, of Painesville, passed away Tuesday, January 12, 2021, at UH Cleveland Medical Center, Cleveland, OH. He was born September 2, 1937, in Cleveland, OH.

A 1956 graduate of Mayfield High School, Chuck entered the U.S. Army at age 19. He served 3 years, spending most of those years in West Germany with the 964th Army Engineers unit.
