Charles Wm. "Chuck" Overbaugh, age 86, of Mentor, died Thursday, Sept. 19, 2013, at Lake West Medical Center, Willoughby. He was born Dec. 7, 1926, in Bellaire.

Mr. Overbaugh was an elementary teacher for fourth and sixth grades at Hopkins Elementary School in the Mentor School System for 30 years until his retirement in 1991. He was a U.S. Navy Seaman 1st Class Veteran of WWII.
