Charles A. Plautz, 95, passed away on August 18, 2020, at home. He was born in Erie, Pennsylvania on June 25, 1925. He was the only son of Virginia and Arthur Plautz of Fairview, Pennsylvania.

He joined the US Army Air Corps in 1942 and served in the Eighth Air Force in B-17s over Europe during World War II. He married Elsie Klimek in 1949.
