Clement H. Kiffmeyer, age 94 of Painesville Twp., OH, formerly of Luxemburg, MN, passed away on May 18, 2026, after a long and fruitful life.

Clement served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict and spent his entire career in the aerospace and medical equipment industry. He is an alumnus of St. Cloud Technical High School, class of 1951, Dunwoodie Industrial Institute, and Milwaukee School of Engineering, class of 1959.

Clement was a strong advocate of supporting and working with the youth of the community. He was an active member in the Boy Scouts of America for 26 years, serving as a cubmaster, committee chairman, scoutmaster, and Philmount Expedition Leader. His efforts earned him the highest civilian scouting award, the coveted Silver Beaver in 1979.
