Clifford C. Hill Jr., age 87, of Mentor (formerly of Euclid), died Sunday November 15, 2015 at University Hospital, Cleveland, surrounded by his sons. He was born September 15, 1928 in Cleveland, OH.

Mr. Hill worked at the former East Ohio Gas Company for 38 years as a material control coordinator until his retirement in 1989. He was a U.S. Army veteran and a proud graduate of Cathedral Latin High School, class of 1946.

Mr. Hill was one the founding parishioners of St. John Vianney Parish in Mentor, OH, where he served as an usher. He enjoyed golf and his walks on the beach in Siesta Key, FL.
