Ms. Panton was an author who wrote under the name Cynthia Mills. One of her greatest accomplishments was the trilogy of novels she wrote centered around true characters involved in the battle of WW1. These were just three of the six books she penned in her lifetime. She was also an accomplished Grant Writer. During her lifetime, she earned a Bachelor's Degree from Lake Erie College in 1983, as well as a Master's Degree in Adult Education and Development from Cleveland State University in 1987. She was also the recipient of the Distinguished Alumnae Award.

Cynthia enjoyed travel, having lived in England for a short time; writing, and gardening. She was also an avid doll collector.
