Daniel E. Pastor, of Mentor, age 85, passed away November 20, 2018. Dan retired from the United States Air Force in 1973 after almost 22 years of service. He worked for a brief time as Parish Administrator for St. Andrew Episcopal Church in Mentor, before continuing his education. He graduated from Lake Erie College in Painesville then obtained his Master's Degree from Mt. St. Joseph. He taught art in the Willoughby-Eastlake school system, retiring in 1994.

Dan is survived by his wife of 57 years, Marilyn "Meb" (nee Moore) Pastor; his son, Kevin Sr.; daughter, Kimberly (Roger) Hutchison; grandsons, Anthony (fiancé Chelsie), Kevin David, Kyle; and granddaughter, Kassandra.
