David J. Hazard, 74 of Concord Township, Ohio passed away Saturday, May 20, 2017 at the David Simpson Hospice House in Euclid, Ohio. Dave was born August 16, 1942 in Denver, Colorado to the late David C. & Kathleen (nee Casey) Hazard. Dave was a Concord Township resident for 29 years.

Dave was the former Director of Human Resources for Rockwell International in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and Columbus, Ohio.
