David W. Wilson, 91, a resident of Concord Township since 1967, died Sept. 18, 2013, at Emeritus of Mentor. He was born Dec. 25, 1921, in Columbus.

Mr. Wilson retired after 20 years of service with Avery Dennison in Painesville. During those years, he was a Research Director for the Specialty Tape Division. His contributions included support for the development of new products such as disposable diaper tabs and self-adhesive postage stamps. He received his Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from The Ohio State University.
