Dennis T. Woods Sr., 83, of Richmond Hts., passed away August 13, 2025, at David Simpson Hospice House, Cleveland. He was born May 22, 1942, in Cleveland, to the late Theodore and Ruth Woods

Mr. Woods was baseball coach for Glenville, St. Anselm's, Lake Catholic and Brush High Schools as well as Tri-C Community College and Case Western Reserve University. He was inducted into the Cleveland South High School Hall of Fame, Glenville High School Hall of Fame, Lake County Captains Crow's Nest Hall of Fame and the Northeast Ohio Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame. Coach Woods is also a proud member of the OHSBCA Hall of Fame. He achieved 801 Career Victories, setting him up as the third most winningest coach in the state of Ohio.

He is survived by many loving family members and friends.

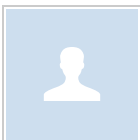
