Domenic J. Vetturini, 91, of Mentor, passed away peacefully September 29, 2024 with his family by his side at the Preserve Senior Living at Mentor Ridge. He was born May 24, 1933 in Jefferson, PA.

Domenic was a proud U.S. Army Veteran who served in the Korean War. Following his service to our country, he worked as an Operating Engineer and was a member of the Local 18 Union for over 50 years.
