Don C. Dangler, 85, of Waite Hill, passed away Tuesday, Nov. 26, 2013, at Fairmount Health Center in Willoughby. Born Nov. 29, 1927, in New York City, N.Y., he had lived in Waite Hill for the past 43 years.

Don was a World War II veteran. He was a teacher at Eastlake Junior High School and Eastlake North High School for 20 years, where he taught history and English. Don was a graduate of Asheville School for Boys in Asheville, N.C., and Ohio University.

Don was a huge Ohio State fan, and a model train enthusiast ever since he had worked on the railroad at a very young age. He was a supporter of girls' basketball at Eastlake North and Gilmour Academy, and Class A baseball in Lake County.
