Doreen Frechette, 99, of Richmond Hts., Ohio and most recently Danbury Senior Living of Mentor, Ohio, passed away peacefully on August 24, 2023. Doreen was born May 31, 1924 in Belfast, Northern Ireland to the late Thomas and Sarah Chambers.

Upon completing high school in Belfast, Doreen wanted to be a botanist, but because of WWII she had to go to work. She worked at Victoria Weaving and Finishing Co. that produced linen and eventually made parachutes for the war effort. Doreen met her future husband, Raymond in 1941 who at the time was in the US Army stationed in Belfast Northern Ireland and they were married two years later. She immigrated to America in 1944 while Raymond was still in the Army in Europe and then reunited in Cleveland, Ohio after the war.

She was a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, aunt and friend to all who knew her.
