Dorotha B. Whitworth Woodard, age 96, of Mentor for the past 35 years, died Saturday, Feb. 8, 2014 at home surrounded by her family. She was born Aug. 29, 1917 in Pittsburgh, Pa.

Mrs. Woodard retired as a Giftware Buyer for Cowell & Hubbard.
