Dorothy Audeen Kubetin, 92, passed away peacefully on Aug. 27, 2017, at the Fairmount Health Center in Willoughby, Ohio. Dorothy was born in Youngstown, Ohio, to Harold and Harriet White and graduated from Collinwood High School in Cleveland.

She worked in steno at Lincoln Electric Co. in Euclid, Ohio, in the late 1940s and early 1950s, left to raise a family, and returned to Lincoln in the mid-1960s. During her second stint at Lincoln, she was the first woman to hold the job of purchasing agent, and was given the first Woman of the Year award at the company, which previously had named only a Man of the Year. Dorothy loved to swim and play golf, and was an accomplished artist in oil and watercolor portrait and landscape painting.

She was predeceased by her loving husband William T. Kubetin and beloved son Mark R. Kubetin. She is survived by son William Randy Kubetin (Sally) and grandchildren Audrey A. Kubetin and William K. Kubetin.

A private family ceremony will be held.
