Douglas Cannon, age 85 of Concord Twp., OH, passed away Monday, March 10, 2025 at home. He was born October 10, 1939 in Vandergrift, PA.

Mr. Cannon was an accomplished engineer, project manager, and business executive who enjoyed a long and distinguished career at Bailey Controls in Wickliffe, OH, where he served in a number of capacities until being named President at age 46. Prior to retiring in 1993, Douglas served as an executive at ITT Fluid Controls in New Jersey.

Doug was an avid golfer who recorded 3 holes-in-one and loved playing at different courses throughout the region. A lifelong learner, Doug read profusely and never turned down an opportunity to discuss and explore. He enjoyed genealogical research and traced the history of both his family and his wife's family. He also learned to speak Italian and worked as an instructor at Lakeland Community College.

Doug never forgot his humble, coal mining roots and lived a life of simple pleasures. Never a man of pomp or pretense, Doug was most happy when he was with his family, working around the yard, walking 18 holes, or learning something new. He will be greatly missed.
