Eileen E. Samson, age 86, of Mentor, died Monday October 12, 2020, at Danbury Senior Living, Mentor. She was born April 4, 1934, in New Kensington, PA.

Mrs. Samson was a retired Lab Technician who tested the adhesive at Avery Dennison for quality control.

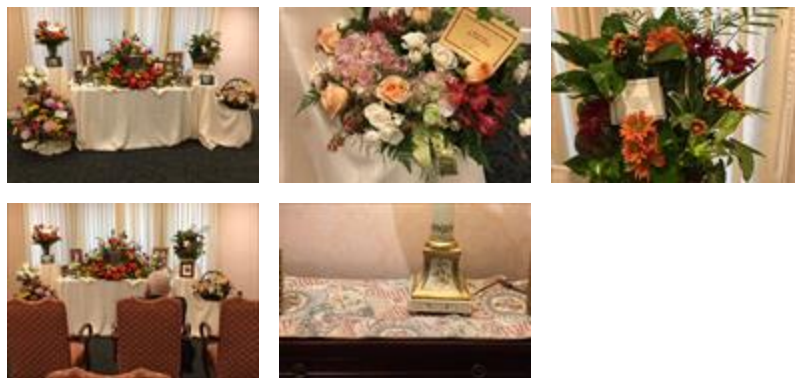
