The Reverend Francis C. Mulvanity, age 81, passed away Saturday, May 24, 2014, after having received the prayerful support and consolation of the Holy Sacraments. Father was born March 4, 1933, in Washington, D.C. to the late George D. and Helen K. (Welch) Mulvanity.

Fr. Mulvanity's first assignment was as Parochial Vicar at St. Gregory the Great in South Euclid. He then went on to serve at St. Bridget of Kildare in Parma, Holy Cross in Euclid, St. Mary of the Assumption in Mentor and St. Paul Church in Euclid. He is survived by his brother, Donald Mulvanity; and many other loving family members.
