



Dr. George T. Wilcox

February 9, 1926 - March 27, 2017

Dr. George T. Wilcox, 91, of Oberlin, formerly of Mentor passed away Monday, March 27, 2017 at Kendal at Oberlin, Oberlin, OH.

George was born on February 9, 1926 in Geneva, Switzerland to parents George Milo and Ruth (Tavender) Wilcox, both of whom were missionaries in Turkey. He met Anne Schein while attending Oberlin College, the two were married in 1952, and had two children.

George graduated from Oberlin College in 1947, received his master's in psychology from Kent State University, and his PhD in Clinical Psychology from Penn State. George was a Korean War veteran, serving in the United States Army, stationed at Letterman Hospital in San Francisco, CA and Fort Smith, AR.

In 1960, George accepted a position with Lake County Mental Health Clinic in Mentor as a clinical psychologist. He was an avid fan of swing and classical jazz music, enjoyed kite flying, delighted in riding his pair of BMW motorcycles, loved studying the history and archeology of the Great Lakes, and rebuilt Ford tractors for the local historical society.

George is survived by his wife, Anne S. Wilcox; sons, Michael (Gaye Mansfield) Wilcox and David (Nance Pettit) Wilcox; grandson, Nathan "Nato"

Pettit-Wilcox and sister, Ruth Wilcox Cruise.

Preceding him in death was his brother, Klages Churchill Wilcox.
