Jaime Felicita Hofstetter Marrison, 44, passed away Friday June 5, 2015 at the Cleveland Clinic after a four year battle with Multiple Myeloma. Jaime lived every day to the fullest, with a big smile on her face. Her family would like you to remember her with laughter.

Jaime was a 1989 Graduate of Jefferson Area High School and 1991 graduate of the Gemological Institute of America in California. She was a Graduate Gemologist and a 3rd generation jeweler at J.R. Hofstetter – The Family Jeweler in Jefferson, Ohio, where she had worked for 25 years.

Jaime's infectious smile and laughter filled any room she walked into. She will always be remembered for her sense of humor, and outgoing personality. She loved to sing and dance wherever she went. Jaime lived more in just 44 years than many could in 100 years. Some of her favorite things included art, reading, traveling, antiquing, going to concerts, and bonding with her family, friends, and pets.

No matter where she went, she made an impact. Anybody who knew Jaime would agree that she touched the hearts of all she met. Even though she was battling a serious illness, she retained her signature positive attitude. She always had a funny joke up her sleeve.

Her survivors include her husband, David; two daughters, Gidget & Analese Marrison; parents Sherry and Jim Hofstetter; brother, Steffel Hofstetter (Ginger Patterson); niece Phoebe Hofstetter, and many extended Aunts, Uncles and Cousins. She was preceded in death by her Uncle Jay Walter and grandparents Carl and Roseanna Hofstetter.
