James E. Boehnlein, age 86, of Painesville for the past five years, formerly of Mentor, died Monday December 21, 2015 at Metro Health Medical Center, Cleveland. He was born March 11, 1929 in Cleveland.

An avid stamp collector and woodworker, Mr. Boehnlein was the retired owner of the Cleveland Specialty Inspection Service (CSIS) in Mentor for fourteen years until his retirement in 2000. Prior to that, he worked as a design engineer for PMC Industries in Wickliffe. A member of St. Bede the Venerable Church, Mentor, Mr. Boehnlein was a graduate of Holy Name High School, Class of 1947, and a US Navy veteran.
