Jane A. (Mills) Crockett, 96, formerly of Eastlake Ohio, passed away February 25, 2017. She was born February 22, 1921. Jane grew up in small coal mining town, by the name of Juniata, in Dunbar Twp. Pennsylvania. As a coal miner's daughter, she learned what hard work was like at an early age. Right out of high school Jane worked at the Juniata Company Store. During WWII she worked as "Rosie the Riveter" at the Fisher Body Plant in Cleveland Ohio.
