Jeffrey P. de la Rosa, 52, died January 31st, 2013 at his Los Angeles home. Jeff was born in Cleveland, Ohio, on June 7, 1960 to Ildefonso (Roger) de la Rosa MD and Rosemary (nee Rocco) de la Rosa.
