John William "Bill" Lutz, age 95, of Painesville for the past 2 years, formerly of Mayfield Heights, died Wednesday November 13, 2013 at Starkey Place in Painesville. He was born July 9, 1918 in Cleveland.

Mr. Lutz was a security guard for Brinks Inc. for 35 years, until his retirement in 1980.
