John (Jack) Francis Mayer, of Conway, SC, passed away surrounded by his family at Conway Medical Center on January 14, 2023. He was 73.

Jack was born on January 26, 1949, in Cleveland Heights, Ohio to John and Ellanor. He was the oldest of seven children.

Jack was a decorated Army veteran who served in the Vietnam War from 1969 – 1971. Jack began a very successful career with The Kiewit Companies in 1984. During his 27-year tenure with Kiewit he worked in Philadelphia, PA, Washington, DC, Pittsburg, PA, Petersburg, WV, Cleveland OH, Baltimore, MD, Chesapeake Bay, MD, Grand Rapids, MI, Boston, MA, Alexandria, VA, Groton, CT, New York, NY, Chicago, IL and Brooklyn, NY. He was an influential individual who had faith in the young people he would mentor. He was admired, respected, and well-loved by those he worked closely with.

Jack retired in 2011 and moved to Conway, SC, with his wife Jamie, where he enjoyed golfing, boating, and fishing. He was a huge sports fan of all things OHIO, although he was not always happy with their performances. Jack was a man of few words, but when he spoke, he had purpose. He was happiest when his kids and grandchildren were visiting and doing what he loved best, being a Pappy.
