Joseph J. Komar, age 85, of Concord, Ohio for the past 3 years formerly of Ashville, NY., died Thursday October 30, 2014 at Hillcrest Hospital in Mayfield Heights, Ohio. He was born June 21, 1929 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Joseph retired from the Army as a Major in 1968. He had served for 20 years, 9 1/2 years overseas, including his service in the Korean and Vietnam Wars. His duties including serving in the Signal Corps in many capacities. After retirement from the Army he worked at University Hospitals of Cleveland for 24 years as Business Manager for the Department of Anesthesia and Director of Purchasing.
