Joseph Sibert, 98, of Mentor, passed away Thursday, Jan. 24, 2013, at Mentor Way Care Center. Born July 15, 1914, in Ruthford, Pa., he was a Euclid resident before moving to Mentor.

Mr. Sibert was a retired plant manager for Old Meadow Creamery in Cleveland, where he worked for 34 years. He then worked as a certified food service sanitarian at Accra Labs for 20 years. Later in his life, he worked for the Lake County Board of MR/DD for 11 years. Mr. Sibert was a past Master of Glenville Masonic Lodge 1618, past High Priest of Glenville Chapter member of Windermere Council, 32nd Degree Mason, past director of East Cleveland Auxiliary Police, and past president of Ohio Dairy Technical Society. He was a U.S. Navy World War II veteran.
