Lewis "Art" Roniger, 86, of Eastlake, passed away June 12, 2022 at home, surrounded by his family. He was born September 13, 1935 in Cleveland, Ohio to the late Gilbert Dunn and Dorothy Demaline.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, where he served along with his brother Gil in the Armored Cavalry Division. He worked as a tool and die machinist at Addressograph-Multigraph in Euclid for 29 years, and at Bethandale Steel in Mentor for 14 more years.
