



Lucille M. Campbell

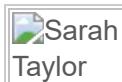
April 6, 1928 - January 11, 2017

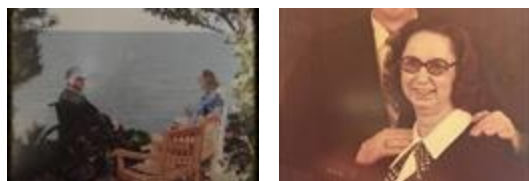
