



Lynn Rosenberg

July 3, 1949 - May 18, 2022

Lynn Rosenberg, 72, of Concord, passed away after a long illness on May 18, 2022 at Geneva Center for Rehabilitation and Nursing. She was born July 3, 1949 in Berea, Ohio to the late George and Kathryn Tyson.

After high school, Lynn studied at Lorain Community College to become a licensed practical nurse. She worked as a nurse at several hospitals on Cleveland's West Side as well as at several nursing and rehabilitation facilities. She then took positions at home care agencies, visiting a number of patients at their homes throughout each day and throughout northeastern Ohio.

Lynn had many interests, and mastered many skills, including gardening, wood carving, quilting, painting (both rocks and canvases), free hand and water painting, drawing, making beautiful lidded fabric boxes, and making costume jewelry.

On a personal level, Lynn had a great love for her children and her husband, and her relationship with her siblings. She had a soft voice and a wonderful sense of humor.

Her primary interest was in animals of all kinds, domestic and wild, large and small, friendly and not-so-friendly, native or exotic. She loved birds and often

nursed back to health a bird that fell from its nest or was injured. The Cleveland Plain Dealer once featured her when she brought back an abandoned baby Blue Jay from near death. Her favorite animals were reptiles, especially snakes and lizards. She had a substantial collection of snakes by the late 1980s and soon met her future husband who, like her, was displaying his reptiles and amphibians at the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo's first "Reptile Fair." She used to say that they didn't marry, but merged their collections. Her favorite reptiles were green iguanas and she soon became known throughout northeastern Ohio as a go-to person for a sick iguana. Lynn always recommended a visit to a veterinarian knowledgeable about reptile care when it was required, but was often able to promote the lizard's recovery by instructing the owner on its proper care and nutrition.

Survivors include her husband of 32 years, Dr. Martin Rosenberg; children, Brian (Lisa) Beavis and Gordon (Ginna) Beavis; grandchildren, Tyler (Stephanie) Beavis and Dustin Beavis; great grandchild, Riley; siblings, Billy, Gregory and Sherral Tyson and cat, Bigfoot.

Preceding Lynn in death are her siblings, George Tyson, Ann Fulton and Terry Tyson.

The family will receive friends from 10:00 am – 12 noon, Thursday, May 26, 2022 at the Brunner Sanden Deitrick Funeral Home & Cremation Center, 8466 Mentor Avenue, Mentor, OH 44060.
