Margaret A. (Bartoroni) Tressler, 85, of Willowick, died September 2, 2025, at Enclave Newell Creek in Mentor. She was born November 15, 1939, in Masontown, PA.

Marge grew up in Masontown, graduated from All Saints High School in 1957, and Uniontown Hospital School of Nursing in 1960.

Following a move to Cleveland, Marge worked 30 years as an ICU nurse at Euclid Hospital before retiring in 2003.

Post retirement, Marge enjoyed baking, sewing, quilting, and daily Mass at St. Mary Magdalene in Willowick, where she was a Eucharistic Minister and avid participant in many parish activities.
