Margaret "Marg" DiSilvestro, 84, of Painesville, passed away Thursday, February 4, 2021 at Tripoint Medical Center, Concord. She was born September 16, 1936 in Cleveland.

Marg was a people person that started back when she graduated from Willoughby Union in 1955 and was Homecoming Queen her senior year. She rejoined her high-school friends 10 years ago and met monthly for lunch reunions. 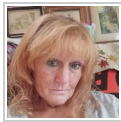

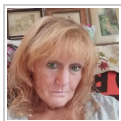
