Margaret "Marge" (Mikus) Germovsek, age 88, passed over peacefully on June 26, 2016, leaving a large loving family who will always cherish her presence in their lives.

She was involved in the First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association, and 82nd Airborne Association, becoming one of the only women in America to become an honorary member in the 82nd Airborne, this was a great honor.

Marge had a great many friends; in her church and community. Everyone loved her and she loved them back! Full of fun, always smiling, ever ready to load up her friends, and family in the car and have a good time, even to

garage sales. Marge traveled extensively with her husband and Airborne friends. In 2001, she traveled to Slovakia with Bishop Roger Gries, and Nuns serving as their interpreter.

Marge is survived by her brother John Mikus; her loving children, Daniel Germovsek (Carol) of Chardon, Robert Germovsek (Sue) of Concord. Twp., Jay Germovsek of Mentor, OH, Kevin Germovsek of Mentor OH.
