



## Marion A. "Mack" Koszewski

Marion A. "Mack" Koszewski, 82, of Painesville Township, died Thursday, Oct. 18, 2012, at Tri-Point Medical Center, Concord Township. Mr. Koszewski was born Feb. 27, 1930, in Cleveland, where he lived until moving to Painesville Township 12 years ago.
