Norman E. Alber, 92, a longtime Mentor resident, died October 2, 2023 at Brookdale Senior Living of Canton. He was born December 29, 1930 in Cleveland.

A U.S. Marine Corps veteran who proudly served his country, Norm worked as a metallurgist at Clevite Corporation, and Gould Corporation and held several patents. His hobbies were woodwork, stained glass, and gardening. (His tomato plants often grew 8-10 feet tall.) Norm enjoyed his family, being a scoutmaster who had 8 Eagle Scouts under his leadership, building things for his children and grandchildren, and serving his church in many different capacities.

Survivors include his children, Roger (Cynthia) Alber, and Diane Weber; grandchildren, Sarah (Jesse) Long, Maggie Alber, Jacob (Brittani) Alber, and Danielle (Wesley) Slack; and his great grandchildren, Matthias, Rylee, Titus, Imogen, and Selah.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Margaret Alber; and his parents, Clarence and Lucy Alber.
